E.g. linking paths from St Georges Basin shops to the Sanctuary Pt Shops, or repairs to the Basin Foreshore Walk, which was severely damaged in the recent storms & floods.

Heritage Estates: Notification from Council of Proposed installation of gates/barriers – Heritage Estate, Worrowing Heights – to restrict vehicle access and to prevent illegal dumping and land degradation.

Email from Narrell was read out, regarding serious accident at **Grevilles Corner Store** – out-of-control car crashed into the kitchen of the store. No injuries, but there was total destruction of the kitchen; the business operating from

the premises will be out of action for months.

Basin Walking Track: Letter needs to be sent to Council, requesting prioritizing of funds to repair this public infrastructure/ asset, subsequent to major damage caused by recent floods. Moved Rebecca, 2nd Chris.

Pathways: Letter from Council regarding linking paths from St Georges Basin to Sanctuary Point, had attached detailed map of proposed routes & priorities. Rebecca took these documents for examination, and will report to Forum at October meeting.

Larmer Avenue Wetland: Deborah Butler of BBCRI is organising a steering committee meeting for this, and seeking suitable date/s for the first meeting.
