- Playground in Old Erowal Bay: SCC has set aside \$100k for this. Now to go out for community consultation.

- Larmer-Mountain traffic & noise. The 50 sign needs to be moved closer to the Wool Rd roundabout to slow down all traffic.

• Forum will send a letter in support of this option.

 Police station siteworks has commenced in Sanctuary Point.
