GENERAL BUSINESS

HOONS: The issue of antisocial behaviour by **'hoons'** in vehicles, was raised. BVF will request a police attendance at a future meeting.

ROADWORKS: A query was raised about the section of **Naval College Road** between the Vincentia roundabout, and the intersection of the Old Erowal Bay road; newly installed safety barriers on a particular bend had been removed; the stretch of road had appeared to have been sealed, then dug-up again, and resealed.

Helga advised that in recent months she has had many sightings of the Yellow-tailed Black Cockatoo, and the endangered Glossy Black Cockatoo, in the local area.

Question was raised about fireworks frequently being let off late at night in early hours of the morning, in the Basin area; speculation as to why & who.
